The Journal of the Indian Institute of Science has been coming out 12 times a year, six being devoted to Engineering and Technology and three each to Physical and Chemical Sciences and Biological Sciences. As you would have noticed we have had difficulties in bringing the issues out in time and a considerable backlog had accumulated.

With a view to streamline the situation and bring out the cover dates into line with the actual dates of publication, we have reluctantly taken the step of rescheduling Volume 64, otherwise due in 1982, to appear in 1983. This would mean no issues dated 1982, but would not result in a break in the serial numbers of the volumes. Subscriptions received for 1982 would be extended to cover an additional year.

To reflect the volume of papers received the spread of the Journal is being made more uniform with four issues each in Sections A, B and C.
