INSTRUCTIONS TO AUTHORS

Manuscripts should be in English and written in a concretionin. A clearly typed original and two copies should be submitted. The text should be typed double spoted with one inch margin on all four sides. The pages should be consecutively numbered and securely fastened.

The Title Page should contain the tollowing:

- (i) the title, which should be brief and specific with words satisfied by indexing.
 (ii) the names of the author(s) and the department(s) where the work was carried out;
- (iii) a footnote, with the present address of the authority of different from that an 100;
- (iv) an abstract not exceeding 200 words, which should summarize the material covered in the
- paper and include the significant results; (r) key words for indexing and information retrieval; (r) the major discipline to which the article belongs, for purposes of indexing; and
- (vi) the major discipling to which the article belongs, for purposes of morning; and
 (vii) a running title, not exceeding 50 characters.

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The Text should begin on page 2, It is prefetable to break up the text into different sections with suitable numbered headings such as: I INTRODUCE, 2, EXPREMENTAL ARRANGEMENT, 3, THEORETICAL ANALYSIS ... T. CONCLUSION and B. ACKNOWLEISHAMINES

References should be indicated in the body of the text by Ataba manerals placed at places, Eg. "Earlier Bose" had measured A loc of the teterrence should be typed in double spacing on a separate sheet in the order of their occurrence in the text and appropriate at the end of the paper. The references should be given with full details as in the following examples:

Tables should be included only if essential. They should be numbered consecutively with Arabic numerals and typed on separate sheets. Every table should contain a descriptive title.

Figures should be drawn with Indian ink on good tracing paper. It is most important that the lines and lettering are sufficiently hold to permit reduction to the Journal pare. Each original drawing should be accompanied by two ammonia prims or Xerox copies. The figure captions should be typed on a separate page.

Mathematical Symbols should be identified with pencil on the left-hand side margin. Standard mathematical notations should be adhered to. Please distinguish between "kay" and "kappa", "ell" and "one" and other similar symbols likely to cause confusion.

Abbreviations, such as eg., et al and i.e., can be used. If non-standard abbreviations or accompans are used they should be explained where they appear first in the text.

Galley Proofs will be sent to the first author for correction. The proofs should be carefully sentinized and corrected and returned within 72 hours of the receipt.

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
